

Applicant Eligibility

SVAC welcomes applications from established and emerging artisans making original work that shows accomplished artistry, design, and quality craftsmanship. Accepted media categories include: baskets, ceramics, decorative fiber, wearable fiber, furniture, glass, jewelry, leather, metal, mixed media, paper, and wood. (Two-dimensional artists should consider SVAC's artist member program and its multiple opportunities for exhibition.)

How to Apply

Please submit an online application at <u>svac.org</u>. Your application should include 3 to 4 high-resolution images along with booth specifications.

Application Due Date

Applications are due by July 31, 2025.

Notification

Applicants will be notified of their application status via email the week of August 4, 2025.

Fees

There is no fee to submit an online application.

Accepted artists will pay a booth fee of \$250 and submit a show contract by September 7, 2025.

Instructions for payment will be outlined in the acceptance letter. Artists will keep all proceeds from work sold.

Booth Specifications

Accepted artists will be allotted an approximately 8' x 8' space and one 6' table. Artists may bring additional lighting (must provide own extension and/or power cords), tables, and display mechanisms.

Preparing Images

Submit high-resolution photography at a resolution of at least 300 dpi. Once accepted, artists are invited to send additional high-resolution product shots to be considered for marketing materials.
